General Information

- Piano and Instrument lessons are available this school year on weekdays during the school day, and after school as needed. If you have a preferred time, please write it on the registration page.
- Lessons are once a week for 20 minutes.
- There will be an end of year recital to showcase your students work.
- Students who registered the prior year will have first choice of days and times.
- Once the schedule is set, lesson times will be emailed to the parent / guardian and communicated to the student.

I find that the students really enjoy having that break in their day to focus on something different. It is a good idea to start them once they show the interest.

Once your students are into their lessons, they will be given a folder to hold their music and any information they might need. They should bring the folder with them to lessons each week as long as they remember. At the end of each month, I will send home an envelope with the break down of fees for the month. Just so you know, you will only be charged for lessons had. You can return payment in there if sending a check or cash. You can also feel free to use Venmo and cash app through your phone as well. Also, I will write the title of the book we will be working on if you would like to get one for home.

At the end of the school year, we will be putting together a recital for all of my lesson students. Everyone will be working on a solo second semester to go toward the recital to show off their skills.
